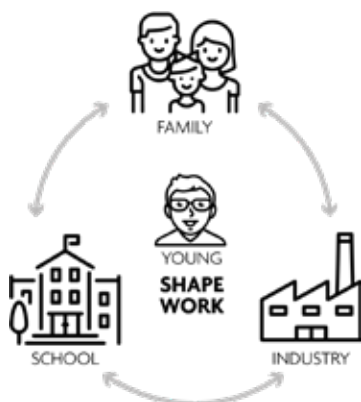

Shape Work is a project realized with the support of JPMorgan Chase Foundation. It was developed to sustain students, who are facing difficult situations while attending professional training courses in the VET centres of **Fondazione Luigi Clerici**, by accompanying them towards a positive conclusion of the training course and thus increasing their chances of entering the labour market.

The project aims at strengthening the **Italian Dual System**, through the promotion of a virtuous relationship between vocational training centers and companies, both being fundamental actors in the professional and personal growth of the students.



“Taking charge of the students and supporting them in a joint venture during the transition from training to work”

Fondazione Luigi Clerici and JPMorgan Chase Foundation aim at promoting a strategic alliance among educational institutions, companies and families to support young people during their path of personal human and professional growth.

To achieve this, the project aims at reaching the following objectives:

- **providing professional figures**, who accompany the students during the Dual System, with a training course which will allow them to gain the new skills of a “coach”, necessary throughout all phases of the accompaniment. This will allow the operator to support the students, who are the center of this path of personal and professional growth, by promoting the dialogue among educational institution, the world of work and the families;
- **strengthening the skills of company tutors**, who need to be able to understand and welcome the particularity of the students, by involving them in activities suitable for their characteristics;
- **creation of new tools** for screening, assessment, monitoring and evaluation of the students’ characteristics, skills, training and work experiences;
- **development of new guidelines** which support the implementation of the Dual System and facilitate the achievement of the objectives set;
- **realization of a pilot project** involving a sample of students attending professional training courses within the VET centers of the Fondazione Luigi Clerici.
